This programme is aimed at students who would like to learn and improve Spanish language and also follow an academic course combined with daily Spanish classes. Students can take bilingual or exclusively Spanish classes.

Students can enjoy an enriching experience that will make them mature and will give them the opportunity to meet different cultures and customs while following an academic programme combined with Spanish classes.

One of the key objectives of the course is to ensure that the student is fully integrated into the programme. The aim and the personal challenge is to achieve the necessary skills and knowledge that will allow them to continue to higher level studies and university entrance, reaching their goals:

- **Individualized education.** Because of personal differences, the learning process is tailored to the needs and capabilities of each student in a cooperative environment
- **Bilingual and international education.** In addition to speaking other languages, students develop an open mind, experience other cultures and learn to adapt to any environment.

- **Training skills and abilities.** It is important that students work to develop skills to help them cope with the constant changes and challenges of the XXI century, in an increasingly complex environment. Creativity and innovation, critical thinking, problem solving, communication skills, collaboration and teamwork are essential to their training.

### ACADEMIC ACTIVITY

Academic activity developed throughout the school day schedule is complemented at residence with science and arts classrooms plus Spanish classes for those students interested in improving the Castilian language. In these classrooms small groups of students meet teachers specialized in the course subjects in order to do homework, widen information or review those things more difficult for you. By combining their schedules, distribution of students



in these classrooms allows them to attend every subject. This system facilitates the individual effort the academic activity requires. Monitored studies are guided by the teacher in each group. Students do group work or individual work using specialized spaces: classrooms, library, computers, whiteboards.... This daily study time is aimed for the students to get a constant habit to reach the academic commitments.

During school hours, the High School will organise, various activities related subjects dealt with, to complement the training of students. Attendance at these activities is mandatory.

# IB® DIPLOMA PROGRAMME

## AN ACTIVE ATTITUDE TO LEARNING

Baccalaureate pupils can choose between three types of pathway:

- Spanish (LOMCE) Baccalaureate.
- The Spanish (LOMCE) Baccalaureate enhanced with subjects from the International Baccalaureate® Diploma Programme taught in English (eIBDP).
- International Baccalaureate® Diploma Programme (IBDP) 100% in English.

The International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma Programme (DP) is a pre-university programme of two years duration from the International Baccalaureate Organisation for highly motivated students from 16 to 18 years of age. Completed with international examinations. Comprised of a curriculum organised around six disciplines belonging to six areas of knowledge and three mandatory central components: Theory of Knowledge; Essay Writing; and Creativity, Action and Service (CAS).

The **IB Diploma Programme (DP)** is an academically challenging and balanced programme of education with final examinations that prepares students, aged 16 to 19, for success at university and life beyond. It has been designed to address the intellectual, social, emotional and physical well-being of students. The programme has gained recognition and respect from the world's leading universities. The Diploma Programme prepares students for effective participation in a rapidly evolving and increasingly global society as they:

- Acquire breadth and depth of knowledge and understanding, studying courses from six subject groups.
- Develop the skills and a positive attitude towards learning that will prepare them for higher education study at least two languages and increase understanding of cultures, including their own.
- Make connections across traditional academic disciplines and explore the nature of knowledge through the programme's unique theory of knowledge course.
- Undertake in-depth research into an area of interest through the lens of one or more academic disciplines in the extended essay.
- Enhance their personal and interpersonal development through creativity, action and service.

## THE IB MISSION

The International Baccalaureate aims to develop inquiring, knowledgeable and caring young people who help to create a better and more peaceful world through intercultural understanding and respect. To this end, the organization works with schools, governments and international organizations to develop challenging programmes of international education and rigorous assessment.
